EQUIPMENT USED: Infrared Sony Camcorder, TriField Natural EM Meter, 35 mm Camera, Digital Camera, IR Thermometer

TECHNICAL EVIDENCE:

Out of 70 pictures **11** came out with numerous orbs. Orbs were caught in motion on videotape. Diane recorded EMF readings that were taken on sum position steady 4 - 8 for several seconds in areas where phenomena was reported.

COMMENTS:

Richard was video taping upstairs; the video camera would go out of focus once in awhile for a few seconds then went back into focus again. When he went upstairs the second time in the same area, it didn't go out of focus at all while he was taping. After viewing the tape the area where the tape was out of focus is one area an orb was caught on tape.

PHENOMENA WITNESSED BY INVESTIGATOR: Virginia Marco

There were six ghosts in the establishment:

- A Native American male of the Cheyenne tribe from the early 1800's. Long brown hair, red/bronze skin, between the ages of 20 - 25, cloths made from animal skins, headband with white feather attached. He was waiting for his people to return for him.

- A 23-year-old girl named Theresa, brunette, hair length to the base on the neck, white skin, burgundy dress, pearl necklace. Love to dance and see people dancing.

- A gambling cowboy from the mid 1800's, black hat, black coat, brown hair, mustache, white skin, around 40 years of age. Made a large amount of noise, was hiding from the group. I demanded him to show himself and immediately there was a large wooden crack. Then he appeared. He was elbowing Diane.

- A Mexican male from the early 1800's bronze skin, husky build, happy, affectionate towards a large bureau. Off-white colored shirt, brown pants, black boots, about 30 years old, died of a heart attack.

- Make drunkard, beer gut, bald with a rim of curly brown hair, white shirt, Levi's jeans, bad breath, around 50 years of age, died in 1972.

- Male with shoulder-length blond hair, skinny, slashed with a knife across the back of the neck 10 - 15 years ago. He was wearing a blue shirt, Levi's jeans, and snake-skin boots.
